Blanks Level One Question Sheet

What is that? (Point to one of the goats, slide 1.)	What is that? (Point to the river, slide 4.)
Who is that? (Point to the troll, slide 5.)	Say this: 'trip trap trip trap.' (Slide 6.)
Say this: 'Then I'm coming to eat you up!' (Slide 8.)	Say this: 'Who goes trip trap over my bridge?' (Slide 12.)
Say this: 'Then I'll wait for him.' (Slide 15.)	Is this a bridge? (Point to the bridge, slide 16.)
Find one like this. (Point to a cloud, slide 21.)	Is this a tree? (Point to one of the trees in the background, slide 21.)
