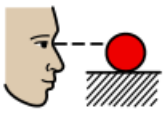

Whatever you do, don't turn the page. . . .

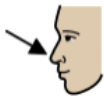


Look at the dragon

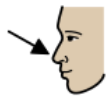


I can't believe you did that!

THAT'S IT!

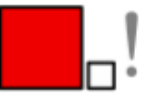
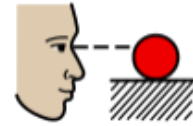
Let's use your *imagination*

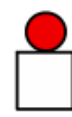

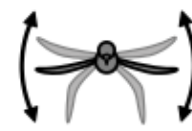


Shoulders sag
